

Shad2024 Application Summary

Shad Canada offers two program experiences: **ShadOnCampus** (in-person) and **ShadAnywhere** (digital). Applicants may apply for one or both programs.

In addition to name, address, contact and demographic information, Shad Canada requires that applicants complete the following.

PERSONAL ACCOMPLISHMENTS

A summary of recent personal experiences, interests and accomplishments. Applicants may include up to 3 items maximum in each section.

- 2. Artistic / Musical Interests
- 3. Athletic Interests
- 1. Activities & Community/Group Involvement 4. Certifications/Scholarships/Awards/Other Recognitions
 - 5. Work Experiences (Paid / Unpaid / Volunteer)
 - 6. Family Responsibilities

ESSAY QUESTIONS

The four essay questions each have a minimum of 100 words and maximum of 250 words:

- 1. Pick a subject (hobby, interest, project or activity) that means a lot to you and describe the impact it has personally had on you and/or others.
- 2. Tell us about a time you failed or struggled at something, or a time you overcame adversity. How did this experience help you grow as a person?
- 3. Tell us about a time you taught yourself something new. What did you teach yourself and what was your motivation? How did you go about your learning?
- 4. Every day we come across problems begging for a solution. Think about a time when you, or a community you are a part of, recognized a problem. Then, think about the initiative you took to create a meaningful solution. Identify the problem and who was most impacted by this issue & tell us how you went about solving the problem.

REFERENCE

Applicants are required to submit the name and email address for a Reference. Once submitted, that Reference contact receives an email from Shad Canada which includes a link to an online reference form. The Reference completes and submits directly to Shad Canada. References are confidential.

BURSARY AND SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

Bursaries: Applicants are required to submit the name and email address for a parent/guardian. Once submitted, the parent/guardian receives an email from Shad Canada which provides details regarding how to be considered for bursary assistance. Information is submitted through an online form directly to Shad Canada and is confidential.

To be considered for scholarship, applicants complete an additional step in the application process.
